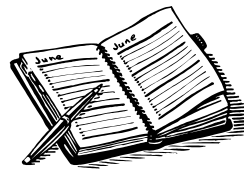

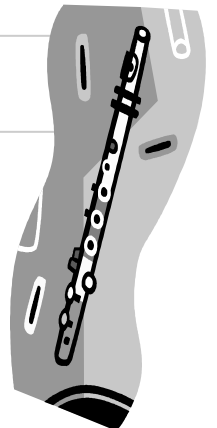

**Directions:** From Capital Beltway (I-495) take Exit 45A (VA 267 Toll W-Dulles Airport) go 6.6 miles to Exit 13 (Wiehle Ave. VA 828-S) go .4 miles, take left onto Wiehle Ave., continue for .2 miles, take right onto Sunrise Valley Dr., go about 1 mile to hotel. (Toll Road, \$1.25 each direction)

**Parent Fee** is a special admission rate for parents of high school and younger students to encourage young flutists to experience the fair with their parents while keeping the cost affordable.
